INSTITUTIONAL SECURITY POLICIES & CRIME STATISTICS

CAMPUS POLICY

The current campus policy regarding criminal actions and/or other emergencies is as follows. In the event that such an occurrence happens on campus, the event should be reported to the Gill-Tech business office immediately. After thorough evaluation of the circumstances, the school will take appropriate action within 24 hours of the report being filed. Those individuals involved are expected to submit a written statement in regard to the situation within 24 hours of the occurrence. The school will contact the appropriate legal authorities if necessary.

CAMPUS SECURITY

The school facility is open to the public Monday through Saturday. All exterior doors are locked and secured during non-business hours. Students are provided with lockers to retain personal items during business hours. It is the student's responsibility to obtain a lock for their locker. Faculty and Staff have access to securable facilities where their personal items may be stored. Faculty, Staff and Students are provided with facilities to secure personal items, thus Gill-Tech Academy cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. Your efforts in timely reporting of criminal actions and/or other emergencies will help to maintain a safe educational environment. A copy of this policy will be given to students at orientation and faculty and staff upon employment and updated and redistributed annually after October 1st changes are made.

VISITOR POLICY

All visitors on premises (inside or outside) must check in with the front desk upon arrival. They will be required to wear a name badge and will be asked to leave campus if they fail to comply with these rules.

ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY

The policies detailed in this supplement shall be enforced by all faculty and staff of Gill-Tech Academy. Criminal actions shall be filed with the Grand Chute police department for further enforcement and legal action. The Grand Chute police will have the authority to arrest individuals.
